

Notice of Open House for Improvements to Ranch to Market Road (RM) 620 in Williamson County From Cornerwood Drive to Deep Wood Drive

The public is invited to an Open House on October 15, 2015, presenting proposed improvements to RM 620 from Cornerwood Drive to Deep Wood Drive, a distance of approximately 2.74 miles. The Open House will be held at the Allen R. Baca Center located at 301 W. Bagdad Ave., Bldg. 2, Round Rock, Texas, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Williamson County, in conjunction with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), will conduct the Open House to gather public input and comments for the project.

The proposed improvements would include the re-striping of existing RM 620 pavement from four lanes to six lanes between Cornerwood Drive and Wyoming Springs Drive and the widening of RM 620 from four lanes to six lanes between Wyoming Springs Drive and Deep Wood Drive. Upon completion, the project will have a roadway section generally containing two 12-foot lanes and one 14-foot lane in each direction; curb and gutter; and a raised center median. Left and right-turn lanes, culverts, water-quality facilities, retaining walls and the construction of sidewalks along the north side of RM 620 are also proposed. Construction is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2016.

The Open House will be informal, and attendees are encouraged to come and go as they please between 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.; there will be no formal presentation. Project maps, exhibits and handouts will be available for review and comment. Representatives from Williamson County and their consultant will be present to answer questions about the project.

The purpose of the proposed improvements is to enhance safety within the project area and improve mobility along the corridor. No new right-of-way acquisition is currently proposed, but temporary construction easements will be required. There would be no displacements by the improvements.

Preliminary maps and exhibits of the project will be on display at the Open House, and are currently available for review at the Williamson County Road and Bridge Office located at 3151 S.E. Inner Loop, Georgetown, Texas, and at the TxDOT Georgetown Area Engineer's Office located at 2727 S. Austin Avenue, Georgetown, Texas. The Open House will be conducted in English.
